# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> Country<sup>®</sup> - Pelt Foxy Buttoned Neckwarmer

**SKILL LEVEL:** Beginner (Level 1)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 6 1/2 x 26 in. (16.5 x 66 cm)

### MATERIALS

- 134-243 [Lion Brand Country: Lobster](#)  
1 Ball (A) *\*Country (Article #134). 100% acrylic; package size: 5.00oz/141.75 gr. (156yds/143m) pull skeins*
- 321-200 [Lion Brand Pelt: Red Fox](#)  
1 Ball (B) *\*Pelt (Article #321). 68% Nylon, 32% Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/50.00 gr. (47yds/43m) pull skeins*
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13 \(9 mm\)](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)
- Additional Materials  
2 buttons, about 1 in. (25 mm) in diameter  
Sewing needle and thread



### GAUGE:

8 half double crochets + 6 1/2 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

### NOTES:

1. Neckwarmer is worked as a rectangle, with a border of B.
2. Buttons are sewn to one end of Neckwarmer. Spaces between stitches are used as buttonholes.

### NECKWARMER

With A, chain 14.

**Row 1:** Half double crochet in 3rd chain from hook and in each chain across – 12 stitches at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across – 12 stitches. Repeat Row 2 until piece measures about 26 in. (66 cm) from beginning.  
Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

**Note:** Wind B into 2 separate balls before beginning.

### **Border**

From right side, join 2 strands of B with slip stitch at right hand corner of one short end of piece.

**Row 1:** Chain 1, work single crochet evenly spaced across short end to next corner, work 3 single crochets in corner, work single crochet evenly spaced across long edge to next corner.

**Row 2:** Chain 1, turn, single crochet in each stitch across long edge to next corner, 3 single crochets in corner, single crochet in each stitch across short edge to end.

Fasten off.

### **Buttons**

From right side, with sewing needle and thread, sew 2 buttons evenly spaced along the short end of Neckwarmer that does not have a border. Use spaces between stitches as buttonholes.

Weave in ends.
