#### **MATERIALS**

- 134-243 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Country: Lobster</u>
   1 Ball (A)
- 321-200 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Pelt: Red Fox</u> 1 Ball (B)
- <u>Lion Brand Crochet</u>
   <u>Hook Size N-13 (9</u>
   <u>mm)</u>
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

\*Country (Article #134). 100% acrylic; package size: 5.00oz/141.75 gr. (156yds/143m) pull skeins



\*<u>Pelt</u> (Article #321). 68% Nylon, 32% Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/50.00 gr. (47yds/43m) pull skeins



#### **GAUGE:**

8 half double crochets + 6 1/2 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

### NOTES:

- 1. Wristers are worked back and forth in rows then seamed, leaving edges of border open.
- 2. Border is worked with 2 strands of B.

## WRISTERS (make 2)

With A, chain 14.

**Row 1:** Half double crochet in 3rd chain from hook and in each chain across – 12 stitches.

**Row 2:** Chain 2, half double crochet in each stitch across.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures about 7 in. (18 cm) from beginning.

Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

**Note:** Wind B into 2 separate balls before beginning.

Border

From right side, join 2 strands of B with a slip stitch to the beginning of last row of Wrister.

**Row 1:** Chain 1, single crochet in each stitch across – 12 stitches.

Row 2: Rep Row 1.

Fasten off.

With A, beginning at top edge without border, sew side edges of Wrister together for 1 in. (2.5 cm), leave next 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) open for thumb, sew remainder of side edges together up to border. Leave border unsewn.

Weave in ends.
