\*<u>Wool-Ease Thick & Quick</u> (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool

Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon

Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon

Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists,

Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)
Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)
Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)



#### **GAUGE:**

3 V-sts = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

V-st (V-stitch) (Hdc, ch 1, hdc) in indicated st or sp.

#### NOTES:

- 1. Piece is worked back and forth in rows, then sewn together to make Circle Scarfie.
- 2. Yarn color is changed to create blocks of color.
- 3. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

#### **CIRCLE SCARFIE**

With A, ch 18.

**Row 1:** V-st in 4th ch from hook, \*sk next 2 ch, V-st in next ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, sk next ch, hdc in last ch – you will have 5 V-sts with 1 hdc at beg and 1 hdc at the end of Row 1.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st, hdc in top of turning ch.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 18 in. (45.5 cm) from beg.

Change to B.

With B, rep Row 2 until piece measures about 36 in. (91.5 cm) from beg.

Change to C.

With C, rep Row 2 until piece measures about 54 in. (137 cm) from beg.

Change to D.

With D, rep Row 2 until piece measures about 72 in. (183 cm) from beg.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

#### **FINISHING**

With yarn tail, sew short ends tog to make Circle Scarfie. Weave in ends.
