## Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® Holiday #Scarfie

**SKILL LEVEL:** Beginner (Level 1)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 6 1/2 x 66 in. (16.5 x 167.5 cm)

### MATERIALS

- 640-501 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Sequoia  
2 Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13 (9 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*\*Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640).*

*Solids, Heathers, Twists: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool*

*Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon*

*Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon*

*Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic*

*Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists,*

*Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)*

*Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)*

*Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*



### GAUGE:

7 hdc + 5 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

### NOTES:

1. Scarfie is worked lengthwise.
2. Hdc sts are worked in back loops to create a textured look.

### SCARFIE

Ch 121.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 120 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in next st and in each st to last st; working in both loops, hdc in last st.

**Rows 3-8:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in next st and in each st to last st; hdc in top of beg ch.

**Row 9:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st and in each st to last st; sc in top of beg ch.  
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
