**MATERIALS**

- 136-125 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn:  
Mammoth Cave  
3 Balls (A)
- 136-126 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn:  
Sequoia  
3 Balls (B)
- 136-135 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn:  
Yosemite  
2 Balls (C)
- 136-122 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn:  
Grand Canyon  
2 Balls (D)
- 136-150 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn:  
Mount Rainier  
2 Balls (E)
- 136-189 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn:  
Isle Royale  
1 Ball (F)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10  
(6 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles

*\*Heartland (Article #136). **Solids:** 100% Acrylic  
**Tweeds:** 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size:

**GAUGE:**

Square I = 8 1/2 x 8 1/2 in. (21.5 x 21.5 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

**NOTES:**

1. Throw is made from 8 Squares and 4 Rectangles sewn tog as shown in Assembly Diagram.
2. Border is worked around entire outer edge of assembled Throw.



**SQUARE I (make 4 – 1 each with B, C, E, and F)**

Ch 3; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this rnd and in all following rnds), 2 dc in ring, (ch 3, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 3; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 12 dc (four 3-dc groups) and 4 ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 2:** Sl st in each dc to first ch-3 sp, (sl st, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in first ch-3 sp (first corner made), \*ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp (corner made); rep from \* around, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 24 dc (eight 3-dc groups), 4 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st in each dc to first ch-3 sp, (sl st, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in first ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 36 dc (twelve 3-dc groups), 8 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 4:** Sl st in each dc to first ch-3 sp, (sl st, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in first ch-3 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, \*ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice; rep from \* around, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 48 dc (sixteen 3-dc groups), 12 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps.

**Rnds 5-7:** Sl st in each dc to first ch-3 sp, (sl st, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in first ch-3 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-3 sp; rep from \* around, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 84 dc (twenty-eight 3-dc groups), 24 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps at the end of Rnd 7.

Fasten off.

**SQUARE II (make 3 – 1 each with B, D, and E)**

Work same as Square I through Rnd 7 – 84 dc (twenty-eight 3-dc groups), 24 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps.

Do not fasten off at the end of Rnd 7.

**Rnds 8-14:** Rep Rnd 5 seven more times – 168 dc (fifty-six 3-dc groups), 52 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps at the end of Rnd 14.

Fasten off.

**SQUARE III (make 1)**

With A, work same as Square I through Rnd 7 – 84 dc (twenty-eight 3-dc groups), 24 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps.

Do not fasten off at the end of Rnd 7.

**Rnds 8-21:** Rep Rnd 5 fourteen more times – 252 dc (eighty-four 3-dc groups), 80 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps at the end of Rnd 14.

Fasten off.

### **RECTANGLE I (make 2 – 1 each with B and D)**

Ch 34.

**Row 1:** Dc in 6th ch from hook (beg ch counts as dc, ch 1), dc in next 2 ch, \*ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next 3 ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, ch 1, sk next ch, dc in last ch – Seven 3-dc groups, 8 ch-1 sps, and a single dc at beg and end of row.

**Notes:** Do not turn your work.

Work now proceeds in rnds all the way around the outer edges of Row 1.

In the next rnd, you will work into the sps at each end of Row 1 and the ch-1 sps across both long edges of Row 1.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this rnd and in all following rnds), do not turn, (2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in sp at end of Row 1; working into ch-1 sps across bottom of Row 1, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 6 times, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in sp at end of Row 1; working into ch-1 sps across top of Row 1, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 6 times, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Eighteen 3-dc groups, 14 ch-1 sps, and 4 ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st in each dc to first ch-3 sp, (sl st, ch 3, 2 dc.

ch 3, 3 dc) in first ch-3 sp (first corner made), ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp (corner made), (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) across to next ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* once more, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to end of rnd, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Twenty-two 3-dc groups, 18 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 4:** Sl st in each dc to first ch-3 sp, (sl st, ch 3, 2 dc.

ch 3, 3 dc) in first ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) across to next ch-3 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to end of rnd, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Twenty-six 3-dc groups, 22 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps.

**Rnds 5-8:** Sl st in each dc to first ch-3 sp, (sl st, ch 3, 2 dc.

ch 3, 3 dc) in first ch-3 sp, \*(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) across to next ch-3 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to end of rnd, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Forty-two 3-dc groups, 38 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps at the end of Rnd 8.

Fasten off.

### **RECTANGLE II (make 2 – 1 each with C and F)**

Ch 62.

**Row 1:** Dc in 6th ch from hook (beg ch counts as dc, ch 1), dc in next 2 ch, \*ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next 3 ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, ch 1, sk next ch, dc in last ch – Fourteen 3-dc groups, 15 ch-1 sps, and a single dc at beg and end of row.

**Notes:** Do not turn your work.

Work now proceeds in rnds all the way around the outer edges of Row 1.

In the next rnd, you will work into the sps at each end of Row 1 and the ch-1 sps across both long edges of Row 1.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this rnd and in all following rnds), do not turn, (2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in sp at end of Row 1; working into ch-1 sps across bottom of Row 1, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 13 times, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in sp at end of Row 1; working into ch-1 sps across top of Row 1, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 13 times, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Thirty-two 3-dc groups, 28 ch-1 sps, and 4 ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st in each dc to first ch-3 sp, (sl st, ch 3, 2 dc.

ch 3, 3 dc) in first ch-3 sp (first corner made), ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp (corner made), (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) across to next ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* once more, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to end of rnd, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Thirty-six 3-dc groups, 32 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 4:** Sl st in each dc to first ch-3 sp, (sl st, ch 3, 2 dc.

ch 3, 3 dc) in first ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) across to next ch-3 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to end of rnd, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Forty 3-dc groups, 36 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps.

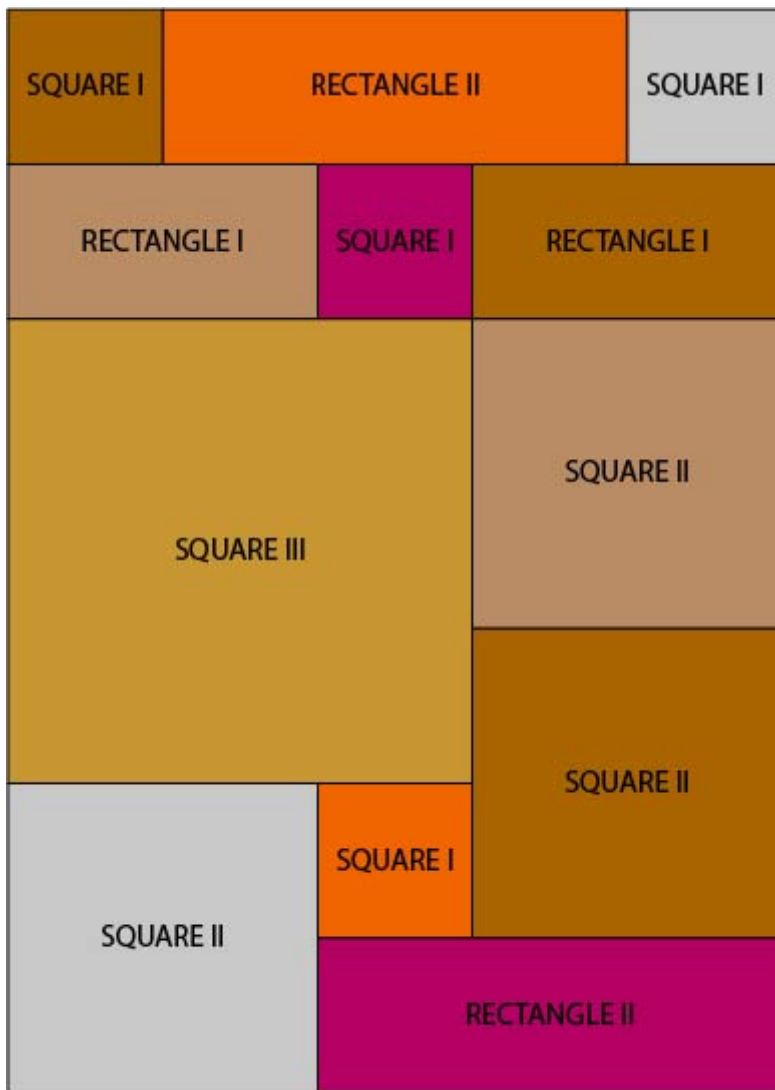
**Rnds 5-8:** Sl st in each dc to first ch-3 sp, (sl st, ch 3, 2 dc.

ch 3, 3 dc) in first ch-3 sp, \*(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) across to next ch-3 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to end of rnd, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Fifty-six 3-dc groups, 52 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps at the end of Rnd 8.

Fasten off.

### **FINISHING**

Sew Squares and Rectangles tog as shown in Assembly Diagram. When sewing pieces tog use the same color yarn as one of the pieces and sew the tops of corresponding 3-dc groups tog.

- #135 Yosemite (C)
- #150 Mount Rainier (E)
- #126 Sequoia (B)
- #122 Grand Canyon (D)
- #189 Isle Royale (F)

**Border**

**Rnd 1 (RS):** From RS, join B with sc anywhere in outer edge of Throw, sc evenly around entire outer edge, working (3 sc, ch 1, 3 sc) in each corner ch-3 sp; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 2 (WS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in each sc around, working (dc, ch 2, dc) in each corner ch-1 sp; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, do not turn, sc in each dc around, working 3 sc in each corner ch-2 sp; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
