MATERIALS

- 640-149 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick](#)
Yarn: Charcoal
1 Ball (A) **Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists, Prints, Stripes: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool*
- 640-099 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick](#)
Yarn: Fisherman
1 Ball (B) *Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon*
- 640-147 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick](#)
Yarn: Eggplant
1 Ball (C) *Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon*
- [Lion Brand Crochet](#)
Hook - Size N-13 (9 mm) *Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)*
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#) *Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)*
Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)



GAUGE:

1 ripple = about 4 3/4 in. (12 cm) measured from peak to peak.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

1. Scarfie is worked in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
2. The ripple in this design is created by skipping 2 sts to form 'valleys' and working a ch-2 to form 'peaks'. In each row, take care to skip the 2 sts in each 'valley' and work a ch-2 at each 'peak.'
3. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and

draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Do not fasten off old color until instructed. Carry colors not in use along side edge of piece.

SCARFIE

With A, ch 23.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as first dc), dc in next 3 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in next 4 ch, ch 2, dc in next 4 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in next 3 ch, 2 dc in last ch – at the end of Row 1 you will have 2 ripples.

Rows 2-4: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in first st, dc in next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in top of turning ch, changing to B in last st of Row 4.

Rows 5 and 6: With B, rep Row 2, changing to A in last st of Row 6.

Rows 7 and 8: With A, rep Row 2, changing to B in last st of Row 8.

Row 9: With B, rep Row 2, changing to C in last st.

Row 10: With C, rep Row 2, changing to A in last st.

Row 11: With A, rep Row 2, changing to B in last st.

Rows 12-59: Rep Rows 9-11 sixteen times.

Fasten off A.

Row 60: With B, rep Row 2, changing to C in last st.

Rows 61 and 62: With C, rep Row 2, changing to B in last st of Row 62.

Rows 63 and 64: With B, rep Row 2, changing to C in last st of Row 64.

Fasten off B.

Rows 65-68: With C, rep Row 2.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
