# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> Hometown USA<sup>®</sup> Fairfield Cowl

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**SKILL LEVEL**: Beginner (Level 1)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 28 in. (71 cm)

Finished Height About 10 in. (25.5 cm)

CORRECTIONS: (applied Apr 28, 2015)

COWL

Cast on 57 55 sts.

#### **MATERIALS**

 135-404 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Hometown USA Yarn:</u> <u>Albuquerque Orange</u> 2 Balls

<u>Lion Brand Knitting</u>
 <u>Needles- Size 13 [9 mm]</u>

• <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> <u>Needles (Set of 6)</u> \*Hometown USA (Article #135).

**Solids, Multis, Neons and Team:** 100% Acrylic

**Tweeds:** 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m)

Multis, Tweeds, Neons, and Team:

4 oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)



#### **GAUGE:**

8 stitches = about 4 in. (10 cm), in pattern.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

### COWL

Cast on 55 sts.

**Row 1:** \*Knit 2, purl 2; repeat from \* to last 3 stitches, knit 2, purl 1. Repeat Row 1 until about 2 yd. (2 m) of yarn remains.

Bind off, but do not cut yarn.

#### **FINISHING**

Thread yarn end into blunt needle and sew sides of Cowl together for about 6 in. (15 cm), leaving remaining 4 in. (10 cm) unsewn for slit.

Weave in ends.
