MATERIALS

- 640-105 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Glacier
1 Ball (A)
- 640-106 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Sky Blue
1 Ball (B)
- 640-131 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Grass
1 Ball (C)
- Lion Brand Size 13 [9 mm] 29-inch [75 cm] Circular Knitting Needles
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool
Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon
Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon
Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)
Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)
Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*



GAUGE:

9 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) over Garter st (k every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Scarfie is worked in 2 sections. Sts for the Second Section are picked up along one edge of the First Section.
2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.
3. Yarn color is changed to create stripes. When changing color in First Section, cut old color, leaving a long yarn tail to weave in later. When changing color in Second Section, carry unused color along side edge of piece until next needed.

SCARFIE

First Section

With A, cast on 70 sts.

Work in Garter st (k every row) for 8 rows.

Cut A and change to B.

With B, work in Garter st for 8 rows.

Cut B and change to C.

With C, work in Garter st for 8 rows.

Bind off.

Second Section

With A, pick up and knit 14 sts evenly spaced across one short side edge of First Section.

Next Row: With A, sl 1, k to end of row.

Rows 1 and 2: With B, sl 1, k to end of row.

Rows 3 and 4: With C, sl 1, k to end of row.

Rows 5 and 6: With A, sl 1, k to end of row.

Rep Rows 1-6 for 41 more times, then rep Rows 1-4 once more.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
