GAUGE:

9 sts + 16 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a

smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Afghan is worked in one piece in Garter st (k every row).
- 2. Following diagram, color is changed to create stripes and blocks of color.
- 3. When changing color within a row, pick up new color from under dropped color to prevent holes from forming in your work. When changing color at the beginning of a row, simply cut old color and begin working with new color, leaving long yarn tails to weave in later.
- 4. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working on straight needles.



AFGHAN

With A, cast on 45 sts; with B cast on 81 sts – 126 sts.

Row 1 (Right Side): With B, k 81 sts; with A, k to end of row.

Rows 2-34: Continue in Garter st (k every row), working A sts with A and B sts with B.

Rows 35-194: Continue in Garter st, changing colors following diagram.

Bind off using matching colors.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
