## Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick®

### I'm A Star #Scarfie

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 4 x 33 in. (10 x 84 cm).

#### MATERIALS

- 640-303 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Constellation](#)  
1 Ball
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 13 \[9 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Stitch Holders](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

*\*Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640).  
Solids, Heathers, Twists: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool  
Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon  
Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon  
Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)  
Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)  
Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*



#### GAUGE:

9 sts + 18 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**Kfb (knit in front and back)** Knit next st without removing it from left hand needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

#### PATTERN STITCH

**K1, p1 Rib (worked over an even number of sts)**

**Row 1:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end of row.

Rep Row 1 for K1, p1 rib.

#### NOTES:

1. Scarfie is worked in one piece with a keyhole opening.
2. Stitches are divided to create an opening for end of Scarfie, then rejoined to finish the Scarfie.

## SCARFIE

Cast on 2 sts.

**Row 1:** Kfb, k1 - 3 sts.

**Row 2:** Kfb, k to end of row.

Rep Row 2 until you have 10 sts.

Work in Garter st (k every row) for 18 rows.

**Next row:** Kfb in each stitch across - you will have 20 sts at the end of this row.

**Dividing Row:** \*K1, sl 1 st to stitch holder; rep from \* to end of row - 10 sts on needle and 10 sts on holder.

Work 10 sts on needle in K1, p1 rib for 3 in. (7.5 cm).

Cut yarn, and sl sts to a second st holder.

Sl 10 sts from first holder back onto needle, join yarn and work in K1, p1 rib for 3 in. (7.5 cm).

**Next (Joining) Row:** \*K1 from needle, k1 from holder; rep from \* to end of row - 20 sts.

**Next Row:** K2tog across - 10 sts.

Work in Garter st until piece measures about 25 in. (63.5 cm) from beg.

Work in K1, p1 rib for 3 in. (7.5 cm).

Work in Garter st for 18 rows.

**Next Row:** K2tog, k to end of row.

Rep last row until you have 2 sts.

Bind off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
