 <u>Wool-Ease Thick & Quick</u>
 <u>Yarn: Grey Marble</u>
 2 Balls

 Lion Brand Size 13 [9 mm] 29-inch [75 cm]
 Circular Knitting Needles

<u>Lion Brand Large-Eye</u>
 Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*<u>Wool-Ease Thick & Quick</u> (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool

Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon

Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82%

Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1%

Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids,

Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106

yd/97 m)

Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m) Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)



GAUGE:

9 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over St st (k on RS, p on WS).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

SPECIAL TECHNIQUE

Cable Cast On *Insert right needle between first 2 sts on left needle; wrap yarn and pull through (as if knitting a st); transfer new st to left needle. Repeat from * for desired number of sts.

NOTES:

- 1. Scarfie is worked lengthwise in one piece.
- 2. Sts are bound off then new sts are cast on to create slits for the modern keyhole.

3. Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of stitches. Work back and forth on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.

SCARFIE

Cast on 135 sts.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: K25, bind off next 10 sts, k to end of row.

Row 5: P to bound-off sts, Cable Cast On 10 sts, p to end of row.

Row 6: Knit.

Row 7: K90, bind off next 10 sts, k to end of row.

Row 8: P to bound-off sts, Cable Cast On 10 sts, p to end of row.

Row 9: Knit.

Rows 10-27: Rep Rows 4-9.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
