#### **MATERIALS**

• 640-123 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Oatmeal 2 Balls

· Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers

• Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

 Additional Materials Circular knitting needle size 13 (9 mm), 24 in. (61 *Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)* cm) long

\*Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists: 80% Acrylic, 20%

Wool

Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4%

Rayon

Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic;

10% Wool; 8% Rayon

Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly: package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists,

Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m) Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)



#### **GAUGE:**

9.1/2 sts + 14 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in Spiral Rib pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

#### **PATTERN STITCH**

Spiral Rib (worked over a multiple of 6 sts + 1 additional st)

**Rnd 1:** \*K3, p3; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Rnd 2:** K2, \*p3, k3; rep from \* to last 5 sts, p3, k2.

**Rnd 3:** K1, \*p3, k3; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 4:** \*P3, k3; rep from \* to last st, p1.

**Rnd 5:** P2, \*k3, p3; rep from\* to last 5 sts, k3, p2.

Rnd 6: P1, \*k3, p3; rep from \* around.

Rep Rnds 1-6 for Spiral Rib.

#### **NOTES:**

Circle Scarfie is worked in one piece in the round in an easy Spiral Rib pattern.

#### CIRCLE SCARFIE

Loosely cast on 61 sts. Place a marker for beg of rnd and join by knitting the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle, being careful not to twist sts.

Beginning with Rnd 1, work in Spiral Rib until piece measures 13 in. (33 cm) from beg.

Bind off loosely while working next rnd of Spiral Rib.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
