**SIZE:** One Size

#### MATERIALS

- 640-099 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Fisherman](#)  
1 Ball (A)
- 640-601 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Hoyas](#)  
1 Ball (B)
- [Lion Brand Size 13 \[9 mm\] 29-inch \[75 cm\] Circular Knitting Needles](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

*\*Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640).  
Solids, Heathers, Twists, Prints, Stripes:  
80% Acrylic, 20% Wool;  
Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool;  
4% Rayon;  
Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82%  
Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon;  
Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1%  
Metallic Poly; package size: Solids,  
Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106  
yd/97 m)  
Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)  
Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*



#### GAUGE:

9 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Basketweave pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

##### PATTERN STITCH

**Basketweave pattern (worked over 14 sts)**

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, (p3, k3) twice, k1.

**Rows 2-4:** K1, then k the knit sts and p the purl sts across to last st, k last st.

**Row 5:** K1, \*k3, p3; rep from \* to last st, k last st.

**Rows 6-8:** K1, then k the knit sts and p the purl sts across to last st, k last st.

Rep Rows 1-8 for Basketweave patt.

#### NOTES:

1. Scarfie is worked in Garter st (k every row) and Basketweave with a ribbed edging.
2. Sts are picked up along one long side of Scarfie for the ribbed edging.
3. A circular needle is used to accommodate the number of sts picked up for the edging. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.

## SCARFIE

With A, cast on 14 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** Working back and forth on circular needle, just as if working on straight needles, work Row 1 of Basketweave patt.

**Rows 2-24:** Continue in Basketweave patt until 24 rows have been worked.

**Rows 25 and 26:** Knit across all sts.

Cut A, change to B.

With B, work in Garter st (k every st on every row) until piece measures about 44 in. (112 cm) from beginning, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Cut B, change to A.

With A, rep Rows 1-24.

Bind off.

## Ribbed Edging

With A, pick up and knit 134 sts evenly spaced along one long side of Scarfie.

**Row 1:** K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* across.

**Rows 2, 3 and 4:** K the knit sts and p the purl sts across.

Bind off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
