# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Homespun® Thick & Quick® Tweedy Slip Stitch Hat And Scarf

Pattern Number: L40048

**SKILL LEVEL:** Intermediate (Level 3)

**SIZE:** One Size

### Hat

**Finished Circumference** About 20 in. (51 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

**Finished Height** About 10 in. (25.5 cm)

### Scarf

About 7 x 60 in. (18 x 152.5 cm)

### MATERIALS

- 792-206 [Lion Brand Homespun Thick & Quick Yarn: Natural Stripes](#)  
1 Ball (A)
- 792-207 [Lion Brand Homespun Thick & Quick Yarn: Greystone Stripes](#)  
1 Ball (B) *\*Homespun® Thick & Quick® (Article #792). 88% Acrylic, 12% Polyester; package size: 8.00oz/227.00 gr. (160yds/146m) pull skeins*

### GAUGE:

11 sts + 23 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Slip Stitch pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**sk2p** Slip 1 as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over – 2 sts decreased.

### PATTERN STITCH

**Slip Stitch Pattern (worked over an even number of sts)**

**Row 1 (RS):** With A, \*k1, sl 1 wyib; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** With A, \*sl 1 wyif, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 3:** With B, \*sl 1 wyib, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 4:** With B, \*k1, sl 1 wyif; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rows 1-4 for Sl st pattern.

## NOTES:

1. Hat and Scarf are worked back in forth in rows on a circular needle as if working on straight needles.
2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts for the Scarf.
3. Color is changed on every other row. Carry color not in use along side edge of the piece until next needed.
4. With yarn in front (wyif) refers to the side of the work facing you as you work the row; with yarn in back (wyib) refers to the side of the work that is away from you as you work the row. To move yarn from front to back or back to front, bring yarn between needles. Take care not to wrap yarn over a needle, this could create an additional st.

## HAT

With A, cast on 56 sts.

Begin with Row 1, rep Rows 1-4 of Sl st pattern until piece measures about 8 in. (20.5 cm) from beginning, end with a Row 4 as the last row you work.

### Shape Crown (top of Hat)

**Row 1 (RS) (Dec):** With A, \*work Row 1 of Sl st pattern across 11 sts, sk2p, place marker (pm); rep from \* twice; work Row 1 of Sl st pattern to last 3 sts, sk2p – 48 sts at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Work Row 2 of Sl st pattern, slipping markers as you come to them.

**Row 3 (Dec):** With B, \*work Row 3 of Sl st pattern to last 3 sts before marker, sk2p, sm; rep from \* twice; work Row 3 of Sl st pattern to last 3 sts, sk2p – 40 sts.

**Row 4:** Work Row 4 of Sl st pattern, slipping markers as you come to them.

**Row 5:** With A, \*work Row 1 of Sl st pattern to 3 sts before marker, sk2p; rep from \* twice; work Row 1 of Sl st pattern to last 3 sts, sk2p – 36 sts.

**Rows 6-12:** Rep Rows 2-5 once, then Rows 2-4 – 8 sts when all decreases have been completed. Cut A.

**Note:** Remove markers as you work the next row.

**Row 13 (Dec):** With B, \*k2tog; rep from \* to end of row – 4 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail through remaining sts and pull to gather. Knot securely. With remaining yarn tail, seam sides to make Hat.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## SCARF

With A, cast on 164 sts.

**Rows 1-38:** Beg with Row 1, rep Rows 1-4 of Sl st pattern, ending with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

**Row 39 (RS):** With A, work Row 3 of Sl st pattern.

With A, bind off in knit.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
