MATERIALS

- 640-513 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick: Seagull
1 Ball (A) **Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool*
- 640-519 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick: Raven
1 Ball (B) *Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon*
- Lion Brand Size 13 [9 mm] 29-inch [75 cm] Circular Knitting Needles *Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon*
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers *Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)*
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6) *Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)*
Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)



GAUGE:

9 sts + 12 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Stockinette st (k every rnd).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

Circle Scarfie is worked in the rnd on a circular needle.

CIRCLE SCARFIE

With A, cast on 130 sts. Place marker for beginning of rnd and join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle, being careful not to twist sts. Work in St st (k every rnd) for 12 rnds.

Cut A and change to B.
With B, work in St st for 12 rnds.
Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
