#### MATERIALS

- 545-203 Lion Brand Landscapes: Sand Dune  
1 Ball (A)
- 321-202 Lion Brand Pelt: Mink  
1 Ball (B)
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials  
Double pointed knitting needles size 10.5 (6.5 mm),  
set of 5

*\*Pelt (Article #321). 68% Nylon, 32% Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/50.00 gr.  
(47yds/43m) pull skeins*



#### GAUGE:

16 sts + 20 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Check pattern with A.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

## STITCH EXPLANATION:

### Check pattern (worked in rnds)

**Rnds 1-4:** \*K3, p3; rep from \* around.

**Rnds 5-8:** \*P3, k3; rep from \* around.

Rep Rnds 1-8 for Check pattern.

## NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in the round in Check pattern with A.
2. Sts are picked up around lower edge of Hat, then edging is worked with B.

## HAT

With A, cast on 72 sts with 18 sts on each of the 4 needles. Place marker for beg of rnd and join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

**Rnds 1-48:** Beg with Rnd 1, work in Check pattern.

**Next Rnd (Decrease Rnd):** K2tog around – at the end of this rnd, you will have 36 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail through rem sts and pull to close top of Hat. Knot securely.

## FINISHING

### Edging

From RS with B, pick up and k 72 sts (18 sts onto each of 4 needles) around lower edge of Hat. Place marker for beg of rnd and join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle Knit 10 rnds.

Bind off.

Weave in ends.
