- 865-203 <u>Lion Brand Vanna's</u> <u>Palettes: Earthy</u> 1 Ball
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size G-6 (4 mm)
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- <u>Fiberloft Polyester Stuffing 12 oz</u> Bag
- Additional Materials
   2 plastic 6 mm safety eyes

# GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

#### **STITCH EXPLANATION:**

**sc2tog (sc decrease)** Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

# NOTES:

- 1. Fox is worked in the round. Work in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.
- 2. Ears, Tail and Arms are worked separately, then sewn to Fox.

#### **Colors of VANNA'S PALETTES**

Brick (A) Beige (B) Olive (C) Pea Green (D) Espresso (E)

#### HEAD/BODY

With A, ch 2.
Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in first ch; place a marker to indicate beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.
Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around 12 sc.
Rnd 3: \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from \* around 18 sc.
Rnd 4: \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from \* around 24 sc.
Rnd 5: \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from \* around 30 sc.
Rnds 6-9: Sc in each sc around.

\*<u>Vanna's Palettes</u> (Article #865). 100% Acrylic; package size: 0.35oz/10.00 gr. (17yds/16m) pull skeins



Change to B. Rnds 10-12: Sc in each sc around. Following package directions, attach safety eyes in center of head on Rnd 10. **Rnd 13:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sc; rep from \* around 24 sc. **Rnd 14:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sc; rep from \* around 18 sc. Stuff head firmly. Rnd 15: Sc in each sc around. Change to C. **Rnd 16:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from \* around 24 sc. Rnd 17: Sc in each sc around. Change to D. Rnd 18: Sc in each sc around. Change to C. Rnds 19 and 20: Sc in each sc around. Change to E. Rnds 21-23: Sc in each sc around. Begin stuffing piece and continue to stuff as you work. **Rnd 24:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sc; rep from \* around 18 sc. **Rnd 25:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next sc; rep from \* around 12 sc. **Rnd 26:** (Sc2tog) around 6 sc. Fasten off. Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Weave tail through last rnd and pull to gather. Knot securely. EARS (make 2) With A, ch 3. **Row 1:** 2 Sc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 sc in next ch 4 sc. Row 2: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in each st across 8 sc. **Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each of next 4 sts, sc2tog 6 sc. **Row 4:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each of next 2 sts, sc2tog 4 sc. Change to E. Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog twice 2 sc. Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog.

Fasten off.

## ARMS (make 2)

With E, ch 2.
Rnd 1: Work 8 sc in first ch; place a marker to indicate beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.
Rnd 2: Sc in each sc around.
Change to C.
Rnds 3-5: Sc in each sc around.
Fasten off.

# TAIL

With A, ch 5.
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across 4 sc.
Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.
Row 3: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st to last st, 2 sc in last st 6 sc.
Change to B.
Row 4: Ch 1, rep Row 3 8 sc.
Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.
Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each of next 4 sts, sc2tog 6 sc.
Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each of next 2 sts, sc2tog 4 sc.
Row 8: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog twice 2 sc.
Row 9: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog.
Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

Stuff Arms lightly and sew to sides of body. Sew Ears to head and Tail to body. With E, embroider a straight st triangle nose between the eyes.
