MATERIALS

- 860-100 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: White

1 Ball (A)

- 860-153 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Black

1 Ball (B)

- 860-113 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Scarlet

1 Ball (C)

- 860-171 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Fern

1 Ball (D)

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6 (4 mm)

- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

- Additional Materials
Small amount of orange yarn

Glass jar, about 6 in. (15 cm) tall

**Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic*

400, 401, 403: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon
402: 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)

Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers: 3 ozs (85 g), 145 yards (133 meters)

Twists: 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)



GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

French Knot Thread needle and bring from back to front through knitted piece. Wrap yarn around needle 3 times, insert needle back into knitted piece close to where it emerged. Tighten knot.

NOTES:

1. Snowman is worked in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.
2. Hat and other small details are worked separately, then sewn to Treat Jar.
3. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st. Do not fasten off old color, carry color not in use along side edge of work.

TREAT JAR

Snowman

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 8 sc in first ch. Place marker (pm) in first stitch for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around – at the end of this rnd you will have 16 sts.

Rnd 3: *2 sc in next st, sc in next st, rep from * around – 24 sts.

Rnd 4: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, rep from * around – 32 sts.

Rnd 5: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, rep from * around – 40 sts.

Rnd 6: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, rep from * around – 48 sts.

Rnd 7: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts, rep from * around – 56 sts.

Rnd 8: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, rep from * around – 64 sts.

Rnds 9-20: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 21: *Sc2tog, sc in next 6 sts, rep from * around – 56 sts.

Rnd 22: *Sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts, rep from * around – 48 sts.

Rnd 23: *Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts, rep from * around – 40 sts.

Rnds 24-26: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 27: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, rep from * around – 48 sts.

Rnd 28: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts, rep from * around – 56 sts.

Rnds 29-35: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 36: *Sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts, rep from * around – 48 sts.

Rnd 37: *Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts, rep from * around – 40 sts.

Rnd 38: *Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts, rep from * around – 32 sts.

Fasten off.

Hat

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in first ch. Pm in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around – 12 sts.

Rnd 3: *2 sc in next st, sc in next st, rep from * around – 18 sts.

Rnd 4: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, rep from * around – 24 sts.

Rnd 5: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, rep from * around – 30 sts.

Rnd 6: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, rep from * around – 36 sts.

Rnd 7: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts, rep from * around – 42 sts.

Rnd 8: Working through the back loops only, sc in each st around.

Rnd 9: *Sc2tog, sc in next 12 sts, rep from * around – 39 sts.

Rnd 10: Sc in first 5 sts, (sc2tog, sc in next 11 sts) twice, sc2tog, sc in last 6 sts – 36 sts.

Rnd 11: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 12: *Sc2tog, sc in next 10 sts, rep from * around – 33 sts.

Rnd 13: Sc the first 4 sts, (sc2tog, sc in next 9 sts) twice, sc2tog, sc in each of last 5 sts – 30 sts.

Rnds 14-15: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 16: Working through the back loops only, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, rep from * around – 36 sts.

Rnd 17: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts, rep from * around – 42 sts.

Rnd 18: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, rep from * around – 48 sts.

Rnd 19: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 7 sts, rep from * around – 54 sts.

Fasten off.

Brim

Note: Brim is worked around Rnd 16 of Hat, the portion of the Hat below the brim is designed to tuck into the top of the Snowman.

From RS, join B with a sl st at Rnd 16 on Hat.

Rnd 1: Working in the 36 front loops from Rnd 16, sc in each st around. Pm in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 2-3: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

Hatband

With C, ch 33.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 32 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Holly Leaf

With D, ch 4.

Rnd 1: Sl st to first ch, ch 3, sl st to first ch, ch 5, sl st to first ch, ch 3, sl st to first ch, ch 3, sl st to first ch.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Scarf

With C, ch 7.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across – 5 hdc.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 2, turn, hdc in each hdc across, changing to D in last st of Row 3.

Rows 4-6: With D, rep Row 2, changing to C in last st of Row 6.

Rows 7-9: With C, rep Row 2, changing to D in last st of Row 9.

Rep Rows 4-9 seven more times, then rep Rows 4-6 once more.

Fasten off.

Nose

With small amount of orange yarn, ch 5.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, hdc in next ch, double crochet in last ch.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

FINISHING

Sew the hatband around the Hat above the brim. Sew the holly leaf to the hatband.

With B, embroider French knot eyes. Sew on nose below eyes.

Weave in ends.

Slip jar into Treat Jar.
