

SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

About 3 1/2 x 4 in. (9 x 10 cm), to hold a standard gift card

1 Ball (A)

1 Ball (B) **Prints**, 7

<u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook</u>
 Size G-6 (4 mm)

• <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye</u> <u>Blunt Needles (Set of 6)</u> *<u>Vanna's Choice</u>® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic

GAUGE:


Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc decrease) Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

- 1. Cozy is worked in one piece and crocheted together.
- 2. Pieces of Bow are worked separately and sewn to finished Cozy.



COZY

With A, ch 13.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 12 sc.

Rows 2-15: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 16: Ch 1, turn, working through front loops only, sc in each sc across.

Rows 17-33: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 34: Rep Row 16.

Rows 35-39: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Fasten off.

BOW

Ribbon

With B, ch 15.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 14 sc.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Fasten off.

Bow Loop

With B, ch 21.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next 8 ch, sc in next 2 ch, dc in next 8 ch, sc in last ch – 20 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, dc in next 8 sts, sc in next 2 sts, dc in next 8 sts, sc in last st.

Fasten off.

Streamers (make 2)

With B, ch 9.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 8 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 6 sc, ch 3, leave remaining 2 sc unworked.

Row 3: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each st across.

Fasten off.

Knot

With B, ch 7.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 6 sc.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Following diagram, fold lower edge of Cozy up along Row 16 to make the pouch, then fold along Row 34 to make the top flap.

Join A with a sl st at lower corner of Cozy. Working through both thicknesses, work sc evenly spaced along this edge up to the flap, working through single thickness of the flap only, sc evenly around top flap, then working through both thicknesses, sc opposite side down to lower edge of Cozy. Fasten off.

Sew ribbon, centered, on front of Cozy.

Sew ends of bow loop together. Wrap the knot around center of the bow loop and sew in place.

Sew streamers to top flap of Cozy, then sew bow on top of streamers.

Weave in ends.
