

GAUGE:

13 half double crochet = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

size: Solids: 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards

Twists: 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111

g), 145 yards (133 meters)

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Scarf is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows.
- 2. Edging is worked along one long side edge of completed Scarf.

3. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the stitch. Fasten off old color.

SCARF

With A, chain 20.

Row 1: Half double crochet in 3rd chain from hook (beginning 2 chain does not count as a stitch), half double crochet in each chain across - at the end of Row 1 you will have 18 stitches. **Rows 2-7:** Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across.

Row 8: Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across, changing to B in last stitch.

Rows 9 and 10: With B, chain 1, turn, single crochet in each stitch across, changing to A in last stitch of Row 10.

Row 11: Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across. Repeat Rows 2-11 for 14 more times, then repeat Rows 2-8 once more. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Edging

Row 1: From right side, join A with a slip stitch in one corner of Scarf to work along one long edge; work single crochet evenly spaced across one long edge (we worked about 160 stitches), changing to B in last stitch.

Rows 2 and 3: With B, chain 1, turn, single crochet in each stitch across, changing to C in last stitch of Row 3.

Rows 4 and 5: With C, chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across.

Fasten off.
