SKILL LEVEL: Beginner (Level 1)

SIZE: One Size

About 7 1/2 x 60 in. (19 x 152.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- 136-126 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Sequoia
1 Ball (A) **Heartland (Article #136). Solids: 100% Acrylic*
- 136-174 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Joshua Tree
1 Ball (B) *Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: Solids: 5oz/142g (251yd/230m)*
Tweeds: 4oz/113g (200yd/183m)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

12 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Scarfie is worked in one piece.
2. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

SCARFIE

With A, ch 181.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across – the 2 skipped ch count as the first hdc, so at the end of Row 1 you will have a total of 180 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, skip first st, hdc in each hdc across.

Rows 3 and 4: Rep Row 2, changing to B in the last st of Row 4.

Rows 5-8: With B, rep Row 2, changing to A in the last st of Row 8.

Row 9-12: With A, rep Row 2, changing to B in the last st of Row 12.

Rows 13-20: Rep Rows 5-12, but do not change color at the end of Row 20.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
