#### MATERIALS

- 640-511 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick: Parakeet](#)  
1 Ball
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13 \(9 mm\)](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

*\*Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists, Prints, Stripes: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool  
Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon  
Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)  
Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)  
Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*



#### GAUGE:

8 hdc + 5 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

8 dc + 4 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### Making a Gauge Swatch

#### NOTES:

1. Cowl is worked as a rectangle and then seamed.
2. Sts are worked in back loops only to create ribbed look. Tall stitches (dc) are worked at one end of every other row to increase the length of the lower edge.

#### COWL

Ch 16.

**Row 1:** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (first 2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and each ch across – 15 hdc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in next 9 sts, dc in next 4 sts, dc in top of beg ch – 10 hdc and 5 dc.

**Row 3:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, working in back loops only hdc in next st and in each st to last st, hdc in top of beg ch – 15 hdc.

**Rows 4-21:** Rep Rows 2 and 3.

**Row 22:** Rep Row 2.

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Sew short ends of piece together to make Cowl.  
Weave in ends.
