# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® - Fun Fur®

### Crochet Snowflake Holiday Stocking

Pattern Number: L40343

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy + (Level 3)

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished circumference** About 12 in. (30.5 cm)

**Finished length** About 23 in. (58.5 cm)

**CORRECTIONS:** (applied Nov 14, 2014)

#### STOCKING

With A B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in first ch.

...

Rnd 6: \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc; rep from \* around – 36 sc.

**Change to A.**

Rnds 7-25: Sc in each sc around.

#### MATERIALS

- 860-107 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Sapphire  
1 Ball (A)
- 860-100 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: White  
1 Ball (B)
- 320-100 Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: White  
1 Ball (C)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*\*Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic*

**400, 401, 403:** 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon  
**402:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)

**Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers:** 3 ozs (85 g) , 145 yards (133 meters)

**Twists:** 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)

*\*Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester; package size: **Solids:** 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls*

**Prints:** 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls

**Exotics:** 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls

**(Note: Exotics shades are lay flat to dry)**



#### GAUGE:

12 sc = 4 in. (10 cm) with A.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

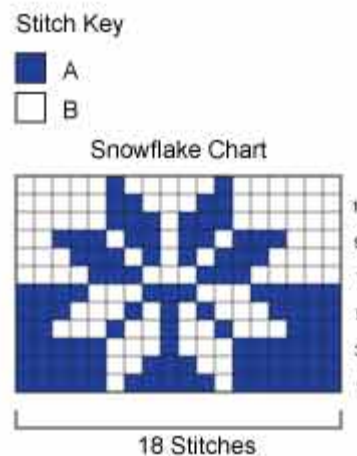
## Making a Gauge Swatch

### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**sc2tog (sc 2 sts together)** (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

### NOTES:

1. Stocking is worked in continuous rnds, beginning at toe.
2. Heel is worked back and forth in rows.
3. Snowflakes are worked following a chart. When working from chart, read every rnd from right to left. Work over yarn color not in use, carrying strand along top of sts while working chart.
4. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete the st.
5. When you see "- 12 sts" in the instructions, this lets you know how many sts you will have at the end of that specific row.



### STOCKING

With B, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in first ch.

Place marker in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each sc around – you will have 12 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 3:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from \* around – 18 sc.

**Rnd 4:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from \* around – 24 sc.

**Rnd 5:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from \* around – 30 sc.

**Rnd 6:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc; rep from \* around – 36 sc.

Change to A.

**Rnds 7-25:** Sc in each sc around.

#### Shape Heel

**Note:** You will now be working in rows across a portion of the sts to shape the heel of the Stocking.

**Row 26:** Change to B and sc in next 18 sts, leave rem sts unworked.

**Row 27:** Ch 1, turn to work on these 18 sts only, sc2tog, sc in each sc to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 16 sc.

**Rows 28-33:** Rep Row 27 – 4 sts rem at the end of Row 33.

**Rows 34-40:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc – 18 sts at the end of Row 40.

#### Shape Leg

**Note:** You will now resume working in the rnd on all sts.

**Rnd 41:** Change to A, ch 1, turn, sc in next 18 sc, sc in rem 18 sc of Rnd 25 – 36 sc at the end of this rnd. Place marker in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnds 42-62:** Sc in each sc around.

**Work Chart**

**Next Rnd:** Continuing to sc in each st around, work Rnd 1 of Snowflake Chart twice around Stocking. Continue in sc and following chart until Rnd 12 has been completed.

**Next 8 Rnds:** With B only, sc in each st around, changing to C in last st of last rnd.

**Next Rnd:** With C, sc in each sc around.

**Last Rnd:** With C, sc in each sc around, join with sl st in beg sc.

Fasten off.

**FINISHING**

Turn Stocking inside out and seam heel.

**Hanging Loop**

Join B with a sl st inside top back of Stocking and ch 15.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end.

Fasten off.

Sew end of hanging loop to inside of Stocking, close to beginning sl st.

Weave in ends.
