MATERIALS

- 860-113 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Scarlet

2 Balls (A)

- 860-194 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Lime

1 Ball (B)

- 860-172 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Kelly Green

1 Ball (C)

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I-9

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic*

400, 401, 403: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon
402: 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)

Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers: 3 ozs (85 g), 145 yards (133 meters)

Twists: 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)



GAUGE:

13 half double crochet = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. 13 Blocks are worked separately, then sewn together to make Scarf.
2. An additional block of color is added to one end of the Scarf.
3. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the stitch. Fasten off old color.

SCARF

Block I (make 7)

With A, chain 15.

Row 1: Half double crochet in 3rd chain from hook (beginning 2 chain does not count as a stitch), half double crochet in each chain across – at the end of Row 1 you will have 13 stitches.

Rows 2 and 3: Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across, changing to B in last stitch of Row 3.

Row 4: With B, repeat Row 2, changing to A in last stitch.

Rows 5-8: With A, chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across.

Row 9: With A, repeat Row 2, changing to B in last stitch.

Row 10: With B, repeat Row 2, changing to A in last stitch.

Rows 11-16: Repeat Rows 5-10.

Row 17-19: With A, chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across. Fasten off.

Block II (make 6)

With A, chain 15.

Row 1: Half double crochet in 3rd chain from hook (beginning 2 chain does not count as a stitch), half double crochet in each chain across – at the end of Row 1 you will have 13 stitches.

Rows 2-6: Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across, changing to B in last stitch of Row 6.

Row 7: With B, repeat Row 6, changing to A in last stitch.

Rows 8-12: Repeat Rows 2-6, changing to B in last stitch of Row 12.

Row 13: With B, repeat Row 6, changing to A in last stitch.

Rows 14-19: With A, chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Beginning with Block I, then alternating Blocks I and II, sew Blocks together into a strip.

Strawberry 'Hull' Block

Row 1: From right side, join C with a slip stitch in one corner of Scarf to work along one short end of Scarf. Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), work 21 half double crochet stitches evenly spaced along end of Scarf.

Rows 2-11: Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
