• 135-133 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Hometown USA Yarn:</u> <u>Syracuse Orange</u>

1 Ball

 Clover Bamboo Circular Knitting Needles 16" Size 13

• <u>Lion Brand Split Ring</u> <u>Stitch Markers</u>

• <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> Needles (Set of 6) \*Hometown USA (Article #135).

Solids, Multis, Neons and Team:

100% Acrylic

**Tweeds:** 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 5 oz. (142 g), 81

yd. (74 m)

Multis, Tweeds, Neons, and Team: 4

oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)



# **GAUGE:**

10 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rnds 1-4.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### NOTES:

Circle Scarfie is worked in one piece in the round on a circular needle.

## CIRCLE SCARFIE

Cast on 48 sts.

Place marker for beg of rnd and join by knitting the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: \*K4, p4; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 2:** P1 \*K4, p4; rep from \* to last 7 sts, k4, p3.

Rnd 3: P2 \*K4, p4; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k4, p2.

Rnd 4: P3 \*K4, p4; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k4, p1.

Rnd 5: \*P4, k4; rep from \* around.

Rnd 6: K1 \*p4, k4; rep from \* to last 7 sts p4, k3.
Rnd 7: K2 \*p4, k4; rep from \* to last 6 sts p4, k2.
Rnd 8: K3 \*p4, k4; rep from \* to last 5 sts p4, k1.
Rep Rnds 1-8 until piece measures about 8 in. (20 cm) from beg.
Bind off.

#### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
