• <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 13 [9 mm]</u>

• <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles</u> (Set of 6) *<u>Hometown USA</u> (Article #135). 100% Acrylic, 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m) 4 oz.

GAUGE:

14 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1 and 2.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

Scarfie is worked in one piece in an easy knit and purl pattern.

SCARFIE

With A, cast on 21 sts.

Row 1: K3, *p3, k3; rep from * across.

Row 2: P1, *k1, p1; rep from * across.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 24 in. (61 cm) from beginning.

Change to B.

With B, rep Rows 1 and 2 until about 1 yd.

(1 m) of B yarn remains.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
