2 Balls (A)

• 495-191 <u>Lion Brand LB Collection</u> <u>Crepe Twist: Plum</u>

2 Balls (B)

• 495-100 <u>Lion Brand LB Collection</u> Crepe Twist: White

1 Ball (C)

 495-126 <u>Lion Brand LB Collection</u> Crepe Twist: Espresso

2 Balls (D)

• 495-153 <u>Lion Brand LB Collection</u> <u>Crepe Twist: Black</u>

2 Balls (E)

*LB Collection Crepe Twist (Article #495). 88% wool, 12% nylon; package size: 1.75oz/50.00 qr. (112yds/102m) pull skeins



*LB Collection Crepe Melange (Article #496). 68% wool, 32% nylon; package size: 1.75oz/50.00 gr. (83yds/76m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

18 sts + 32 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in Seed st.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

3/3 LC (3 over 3 left cross) Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k3, then k3 from cable needle. **3/3 RC (3 over 3 right cross)** Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k3, then k3 from cable needle. **yo (yarn over)**

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the

next st as instructed.

PATTERN STITCH

Seed St (over an even number of sts)


Row 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: P the knit sts and k the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for Seed st.

NOTES:

- 1. Poncho is made from 5 Strips, worked in different pattern stitches and yarn colors. Strips are sewn tog following a diagram to make the Poncho.
- 2. When changing color, do not cut old color until instructed. Carry color not in use along the side edge of piece.
- 3. With yarn in front (wyif) refers to the side of the work facing you as you work the row; with yarn in back (wyib) refers to the side of the work that is away from you as you work the row. To move yarn from front to back or back to front, bring yarn between needles. Take care not to wrap yarn over a needle, this could create an additional st.
- 4. Always slip sts as if to purl.



PONCHO

STRIP I

With B, cast on 14 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: K7, 3/3 RC, k1.

Row 4: Purl.

Rows 5 and 6: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Row 7: K1, 3/3 LC, k7.

Row 8: Purl.

Rows 9 and 10: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Row 11: K4, 3/3 LC, k4.

Row 12: Purl.

Rep Rows 1-12 until piece measures about 52 in. (132 cm) from beg.

Bind off.

STRIP II

With F, cast on 30 sts.

Row 1 (RS): With F, knit.

Row 2: With F, purl.

Row 3: With E, *k2, sl 1 wyib; rep from * to end of row.

Row 4: With E, *sl 1 wyif, k2; rep from * to end of row.

Rep Rows 1-4 until piece measures about 52 in. (132 cm) from beg; end with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

Bind off.

STRIP III

With E, cast on 18 sts.

Row 1 (RS): With E, knit.

Row 2: With E, knit.

Rows 3 and 4: With C, knit. Rows 5 and 6: With E, knit.

Rows 7-10: Rep Rows 3-6.

Cut C and E.

Row 11: With B, knit.

Rows 12-34: With B, work in Seed st.

Cut B.

Rows 35-44: Rep Rows 1-10.

Cut C and E.

Row 45: With A, knit.

Rows 46-68: With A, work in Seed st.

Cut A.

Rep Rows 1-68 five more times, then rep Rows 1-44 once more.

Bind off.

STRIP IV

With D, cast on 26 sts.

Row 1 (RS): With D, knit.

Row 2: With D, purl.

Row 3: With C, k1, *sl 3 wyib, k1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 4: With C, p1, *k1, sl 3 wyif; rep from * to last st, p1.

Rows 5 and 6: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Row 7: With C, k1, sl 1 wyib, *k1, sl 3 wyib; rep from * to last 4 sts, k1, sl 2 wyib, k1.

Row 8: With C, p1, sl 2 wyif, *k1, sl 3 wyif; rep from * to last 3 sts, k1, sl 1 wyif, p1.

Rep Rows 1-8 until piece measures about 52 in. (132 cm) from beg; end with a Row 2 as the last row you work. Bind off.

STRIP V

With A, cast on 9 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K3, yo, k2tog, k4.

Row 2: Knit.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 52 in. (132 cm) from beg; end with a Row 2 as the last row you work. Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew Strips tog following diagram. Fold piece in half and sew edges of one side tog, leaving 10 in. (25.5 cm) unsewn at fold for neck opening.

Weave in ends.
