MATERIALS

- 545-202 Lion Brand Landscapes: Mountain Range 2 Balls
**Landscapes (Article #545). 100% acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (147yds/134m) pull skeins*
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 10 [6 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

16 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Scarfie is worked in 2 sections.
2. Both sections are worked in Garter st (knit every row), slipping the first st of every row to create a tidy edge. The designer slipped the first st as if to knit – but we encourage you to experiment and see whether you like that look or if you prefer to slip the first st as if to purl.
3. Sts for the second section are picked up along one side of the first section of the Scarfie.

SCARFIE

First Section

Cast on 64 sts.

Work in Garter st (knit every row), slipping the first st of every row, until piece measures about 7 in. (18 cm) from beginning.

Bind off.

Second Section

Notes:

1. For the second section, you will be picking up sts evenly spaced along the first section of the Scarfie. The numbers provided in the instructions are the number that the designer picked up – but every knitter's gauge is a bit different! If desired, pick up more or fewer sts than specified.

Working along a 7 in. (18 cm) side of First Section, pick up and k28 sts evenly spaced across. Work in Garter st, slipping the first st of every row, until about 3 yd. (3 m) of yarn remains. Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
