GAUGE:

 $12 \frac{1}{2} \text{ sts} + 17 \text{ rows} = \text{about 4 in.}$ (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with one strand each of A and one of the yarn colors in the B package held together.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for

Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Mat is worked in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with a Garter st (k every row) border, using 2 strands of yarn held together.
- 2. Embroidery is worked onto completed Mat.

Colors for B yarns

White with red sparkle (C)
White with silver sparkle (D)
White with green sparkle (E)
Green with emerald sparkle (F)
Scarlet with red sparkle (G)
Medium red (H)

TABLE MAT

Note: The Mat is worked with one strand of A and one strand of one of the yarns from the B yarn package held tog.

With one strand of A and one strand of C held tog, cast on 50 sts.

Knit 6 rows.

Row 1 (WS): K4 for Garter st (k every row) border, p to last 4 sts for St st (k on RS, p on WS), k last 4 sts.

Row 2: Knit.

Keeping first and last 4 sts in Garter st and remaining sts in St st, work until piece measures about 4 in. (10 cm) from beg.

Cut C and change to D.

With one strand of A and one strand of D held tog, and keeping first and last 4 sts in Garter st and remaining sts in St st as established, work until piece measures about 8 in. (20 cm) from beg. Cut D and change to E.

With one strand of A and one strand of E held tog, and keeping first and last 4 sts in Garter st and remaining sts in St st as established, work until piece measures about 11 in. (28 cm) from beg. Continuing with one strand of A and one strand of E held tog, knit 6 rows. Bind off.

FINISHING

Draw a triangle onto paper, about 7 in. (18 cm) tall, with a base about 5 1/2 in. (14 cm) wide. Cut out the triangle shape.

Lay Mat onto a flat surface and pin paper triangle to center of Mat.

With F threaded into blunt needle, embroider straight sts just outside the paper tree shape.

Remove paper shape leaving the embroidered tree outline on the Mat.

With F, fill in the tree shape by embroidering cross stitches across every other row of the Mat, within the tree shape.

With G, embroider scattered French knots between the rows of cross stitches.

With G, embroider a straight st with a cross st on top of the straight st to make a star at the top of the tree.

With H, embroider 4 cross sts centered across base of tree for trunk. Continuing with H, embroider 2 more rows of cross sts to complete the trunk.

Weave in ends.
