## Lion Brand® Heartland

### Warm Heart #Scarfie

Pattern Number: L40592

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 7 x 44 in. (18 x 112 cm)

#### MATERIALS

- 136-135 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Yosemite 1 Ball *\*Heartland (Article #136). Solids: 100% Acrylic*
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9 [5.5 mm] *Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: Solids: 5oz/142g (251yd/230m)*
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers *Tweeds: 4oz/113g (200yd/183m)*
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



#### GAUGE:

16 sts + 22 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Pyramid pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

##### PATTERN STITCH

**Pyramid Pattern (worked over a multiple of 6 sts + 5 extra sts)**

**Row 1 (RS):** K5, \*p1, k5; rep from \* to end of row.

**Rows 2 and 5:** K1, \*p3, k3; rep from \* to last 4 sts, p3, k1.

**Rows 3 and 4:** P2, \*k1, p5; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

**Row 6:** Rep Row 1.

Repeat Rows 1-6 for Pyramid Pattern.

#### NOTES:

1. Scarfie is worked in one piece in a Pyramid Pattern. Note that some rows of the Pyramid Pattern are worked on both the right and the wrong side of the Scarfie.
2. A Garter st (k every row) border is worked at beginning and end of Scarfie and along side

edges.

## SCARFIE

Cast on 29 sts.

### Beginning Border

Work in Garter st (k every row) for 6 rows.

### Pyramid Pattern

**Row 1 (RS):** K3 for Garter st border, place marker (pm), work Row 1 of Pyramid pattern to last 3 sts, pm, k3 for Garter st border.

**Row 2:** K3, slip marker (sm), work Row 2 of Pyramid pattern to marker, sm, k3.

**Next Row:** K3, sm, work next row of Pyramid pattern to marker, sm, k3.

Rep last row until piece measures about 43 in. (109 cm) from beg, end with a Row 6 of Pyramid pattern as the last row you work.

### Ending Border

Work in Garter st for 6 rows.

Bind off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
