thin, bendable wire (or a 8 x .35oz/10g large paper clip, unbent) 8 x 28yd/26m

MATERIALS NOTE

Materials are sufficient 8 x .35 to make about 36 8 x 28

Braids.

Acrylic: Weight Category 3: DK Weight

8 x .35oz/10g 8 x 28yd/26m

Metallic: Weight Category 2: Sport Weight

8 x .35oz/10g 8 x 38.3 yd/35m



Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

BRAID

For each Braid, cut 4 strands each of 3 colors of yarn, with each strand about 22 in. (56 cm) long. Knot strands together at one end.

Divide strands into 3 groups of 4 strands each and braid for about 11 in. (28 cm), then knot all strands together.

FINISHING

Trim yarn ends about 1 in. (2.5 cm) past each knot.

Bend wire in half, then insert folded end through hole in bead. Draw Braid through folded wire, then pull
