1 Ball
- Additional Materials
Beads with large holes,
one for each Braid
About 6 in. (15 cm) of
thin, bendable wire (or a
large paper clip, unbent)

Cotton: 100% Cotton. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Gentle Cycle, Do Not Bleach, Dry Flat, Low Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

Acrylic: 100% Acrylic. **Care:** Machine Wash and Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Tumble Dry Normal, Dry Clean and Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

Metallic: 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Lay Flat to Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.;
package size: **Cotton:** Weight Category 2: Sport Weight

GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

BRAID

For each Braid, cut 4 strands each of 3 colors of yarn, with each strand about 22 in. (56 cm) long. Knot strands together at one end.

Divide strands into 3 groups of 4 strands each and braid for about 11 in. (28 cm), then knot all strands together.

FINISHING

Trim yarn ends about 1 in. (2.5 cm) past each knot.

Bend wire in half, then insert folded end through hole in bead. Draw Braid through folded wire, then pull

wire back to draw Braid through the bead hole far enough to make a large loop.
