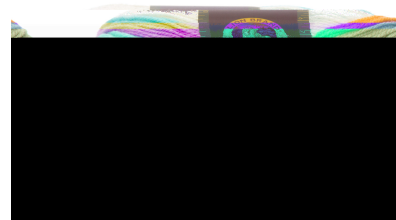

MATERIALS

- 923-207 Lion Brand Ice Cream: Strawberry 1 Ball **Ice Cream (Article #923). 100% Acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (394yds/360m) pull skeins*
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6 (4 mm)
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

16 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

hdc2tog (hdc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

1. Booties and Mitts are worked in continuous rnds; Booties beg at center of sole. Do not join and do not turn at the end of rnds.
2. Hat is worked in joined rnds beg at top of Hat. Join each rnd with a sl st in the first st of the rnd. Do not turn at the end of rnds.

BOOTIES (make 2)

Sole

With A, ch 13.

Note: Rnd 1 is worked along both sides of the foundation ch.

Rnd 1 (RS): Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 8 ch, hdc in next ch, 2 hdc in next ch, 4 hdc in last ch; working across opposite side of foundation ch, 2 hdc in next ch, hdc in next ch, sc in next 8 ch, 2 sc in last ch; do not join, work in continuous rnds – 30 sts. Place marker to indicate beg of rnd.

Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in next st, sc in next 12 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 12 sts, 2 sc in last st – 34 sts.

Rnd 3: Work 2 sc in next st, sc in next 13 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 13 sts, 2 sc in last st – 38 sts.

Rnd 4: Work 2 sc in next st, sc in next 14 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 14 sts, 2 sc in last st – 42 sts.

Shape Sides

Rnd 5: Working through back loops only, sc in each st around.

Resume working through both loops of sts.

Rnds 6 and 7: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 8: Sc in next 14 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st, hdc in next st, hdc2tog, hdc in next 2 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in next st, sc in next st, sc2tog, sc in next 14 sts – 38 sts.

Rnd 9: Sc in next 12 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st, hdc in next st, hdc2tog, hdc in next 2 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in next st, sc in next st, sc2tog, sc in next 12 sts – 34 sts.

Rnd 10: Sc in next 10 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st, hdc in next st, hdc2tog, hdc in next 2 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in next st, sc in next st, sc2tog, sc in next 10 sts – 30 sts.

Rnd 11: Sc in next 9 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st, hdc2tog, hdc in next 2 sts, hdc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog, sc in next 9 sts – 26 sts.

Rnds 12 and 13: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 14: *Sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * around; sl st in first st – 13 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 15: Sc in each st and ch-1 sp around – 26 sts.

Rnd 16: (Sl st, ch 4, sl st) in each st around; join with sl st in first sl st – 26 (sl st, ch 4, sl st) picots.

Fasten off.

TIES (make 2)

Ch 5, sl st in 5th ch from hook, ch for about 16 in. (40.5 cm), sl st in 5th ch from hook.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Beg and ending at center front, weave a Tie through ch-1 sps of Rnd 14 on each Bootie.

HAT

Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into yarn ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Rnd 1 into the ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work 8 sc in ch; join with sl st in first sc. Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Note: Work the first sc of each rnd in the same st as the joining.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, work 2 sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc – 16 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, *2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 24 sc.

Rnds 4, 6, 8, 10, 12 and 14: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 32 sc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 40 sc.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 48 sc.

Rnd 11: Ch 1, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 56 sc.

Rnd 13: Ch 1, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 64 sc.

Rnd 15: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in next st and in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 64 hdc.

Rnd 16: Ch 1, sc in first st, *ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from * to last st, ch 1, sk last st; join with sl st in first sc – 32 sc and 32 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 17: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in each ch-1 sp and sc around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 64 hdc.

Rnd 18: Ch 1, sc in first st, *ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from * to last st, sk last st; join with sl st in first sc – 32 sc and 32 ch-1 sps.

Rnds 19-24: Rep Rnds 17 and 18.

Rnd 25: Ch 1, sc in each sc and ch-1 sp around; join with sl st in first sc – 64 sc.

Rnd 26: (Sl st, ch 4, sl st) in each st around; join with sl st in first sl st – 64 picots. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

MITTS (make 2)

Ch 5.

Note: Rnd 1 is worked along both sides of the foundation ch.

Rnd 1: Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 2 ch, 4 sc in last ch; turn to work along opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 2 ch, 2 sc in last ch – you will have 12 sts at the end of this rnd.

Place marker to indicate beg of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, (2 sc in next st) twice, sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in last st – 16 sts.

Rnd 3: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 4: 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, (2 sc in next st) twice, sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in last st – 20 sts.

Rnd 5: Rep Rnd 3.

Rnd 6: 2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts, (2 sc in next st) twice, sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in last st – 24 sts.

Rnds 7-12: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 13: *Sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * around, sl st in first st – 12 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 14: Sc in each st and ch-1 sp around – 24 sts.

Rnd 15: *(Sl st, ch 4, sl st) in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sl st.

Fasten off.

TIES (make 2)

Ch 5, sl st in 5th ch from hook, ch for about 14 in. (35.5 cm), sl st in 5th ch from hook.

Fasten off.

Beg and ending at center front, weave a Tie through ch-1 sps of Rnd 13 on each Mitt.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
