MATERIALS

- 860-172 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Kelly Green

1 Ball (A)

**Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic*

- 860-180 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Cranberry

1 Ball (B)

400, 401, 403: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon
402: 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)

- 860-113 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Scarlet

2 Balls (C)

Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers: 3 ozs (85 g) , 145 yards (133 meters)

Twists: 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

11 1/2 half double crochet = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Scarf is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows.
2. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Fasten off old color.

SCARF

With A, chain 22.

Row 1: Half double crochet in 3rd chain from hook (beginning 2 chain does not count as a stitch), half

double crochet in each chain across – at the end of Row 1 you will have 20 stitches.

Rows 2-19: Chain 2, turn, half double crochet in each stitch across.

Row 20: Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across, changing to B in last stitch.

Rows 21-24: With B, chain 2, turn, half double crochet in each stitch across.

Row 25: Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across, changing to C in last stitch.

Rows 26-37: With C, chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across.

Row 38: Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across, changing to B in last stitch.

Rows 39-41: With B, chain 2, turn, half double crochet in each stitch across.

Row 42: Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across, changing to C in last stitch.

Rows 43-144: Repeat Rows 26-42 six times.

Do not change to C at the end of Row 144.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
