SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 20 in. (51 cm)

Finished Height About 6 1/2 in. (16.5 cm)

CORRECTIONS: (applied Nov 25, 2015)

CIRCLE SCARFIE

Ch 42; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), **place marker in beg ch to mark beg of rnd and move marker up as you finish each rnd**, hdc in next ch and each ch around; join with sl st in top of beg ch - you will have 42 hdc.

MATERIALS

- 135-208 Lion Brand Hometown USA Yarn: Phoenix Azalea
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13 (9 mm)
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Hometown USA (Article #135). Solids, Multis, Neons and Twists: 100% Acrylic, Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: Solids: 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m) Multis, Tweeds, Neons, and Twists: 4 oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)*



GAUGE:

8 1/2 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Circle Scarfie is worked in joined rnds. Do not turn at beg of rnds.
2. If you find it difficult to join the beg ch into a ring without twisting the ch, Rnd 1 can be worked as a row, then joined into a rnd, as follows: Leaving a long beg tail, ch 43, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and each ch across; join with sl st in top of beg ch – you will have 42 hdc. Use beg tail to sew gap at base of first row closed. Proceed to Rnd 2.

CIRCLE SCARFIE

Ch 42; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), place marker in beg ch to mark beg of rnd and move marker up as you finish each rnd, hdc in next ch and each ch around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – you will have 42 hdc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Repeat Rnd 2 until piece measures about 6 1/2 in. (16.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
