#### **MATERIALS**

• 135-113 Lion Brand Hometown USA Yarn: Cincinnati Red 2 Balls

• Lion Brand Crochet Hook -Size N-13 (9 mm)

 Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6) \*Hometown USA (Article #135). Solids,

Multis, Neons and Team: 100%

Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: Solids: 5 oz. (142 g), 81

yd. (74 m)

Multis, Tweeds, Neons, and Team: 4

oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)



# **GAUGE:**

9 1/2 sts + 7 1/2 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in (ch 1, sc worked in back loop) pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

# NOTES:

- 1. Scarfie is worked lengthwise, with sts worked through the back loops to create a ribbed look.
- 2. A slip st trim is worked across both ends of Scarfie.

### SCARFIE

Ch 134.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook \*ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* across - you will have 67 sc and 66 ch-1 sps at the end of Row 1.

Rows 2-10: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in first sc, \*ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc; rep from \* across.

Do not fasten off at the end of Row 10.

# First End Trim

Ch 1, turn to work across ends of rows and work 6 sl sts spaced evenly across.

Fasten off.

#### Second End Trim

From RS, join yarn with a sl st in opposite corner of Scarfie so that you are ready to work across the opposite end.

Work 5 more sl sts evenly spaced across end.

Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
