**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** Child (Multiple Sizes)

### AFGHAN

About 25 x 40 in. (63.5 x 101.5 cm)

### HAT

Child's S (M, L)

**Finished Circumference** About 16 (17 ½, 19) in. (40.5 (44.5, 48.5) cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

**Finished Length** About 6 1/2 (7, 7 1/2) in. (16.5 (18, 19) cm)

### MATERIALS

- 136-105 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Glacier Bay

1 Ball (A)

- 136-103 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Denali

1 Ball (B)

- 136-169 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Shenandoah

1 Ball (C)

- 136-398 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Acadia Tweed

1 Ball (D)

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*\*Heartland (Article #136). Solids: 100% Acrylic*

*Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: Solids: 5oz/142g (251yd/230m)*

*Tweeds: 4oz/113g (200yd/183m)*



### GAUGE:

13 hdc + 10 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

12 sc + 15 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

### NOTES:

1. Afghan is worked in one piece, changing color to create stripes.
2. Hat is worked in one piece in the rnd.



### **STRIPE SEQUENCE**

\*Work 13 rows with A, 13 rows with B, 13 rows with C, 10 rows with D; rep from \* once more for Stripe Sequence.

### **AFGHAN**

With A, ch 82.

**Row 1 (RS):** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first hdc) and in each ch across – 81 hdc.

**Rows 2:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, hdc in next st and in each st across.

**Rows 3-98:** Continuing with Stripe Sequence, rep Row 2, changing color in the last st of the last row of each stripe.

Fasten off.

### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

### **HAT**

With B, ch 4.

Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, work 5 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, work 2 sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc – 10 sc.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from \* to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 15 sc.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from \* to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 20 sc.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 1, sc in first 3 sc, \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from \* to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 25 sc.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc, \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc; rep from \* to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 30 sc.

**Rnd 7:** Rep Rnd 6 – 36 sc.

**Rnd 8:** Ch 1, sc in first 5 sc, \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc; rep from \* to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 42 sc.

**Rnd 9:** Ch 1, sc in first 6 sc, \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc; rep from \* to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 48 sc.

#### **SIZES M (L) ONLY**

**Rnd 10:** Ch 1, sc in first 11 sc, \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc; rep from \* to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 48 (52, 52) sc.

#### **SIZE L ONLY**

**Rnd 11:** Ch 1, sc in first 6 sc, \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 12 sc; rep from \* to last 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last 6 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 48 (52, 56) sc.

#### **ALL SIZES**

**Rnds 10-20 (11-21, 12-22):** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off B.

Join D with sl st in joining st.

**Rnds 21-25 (22-26, 23-27):** With D, ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
