SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: 2-3 yrs, Child 3-7, Child 8-10

SCARF

About 6 x 40 in. (15 x 101 cm)

HAT

Child's S (M, L)

Finished Circumference About 15 (17, 19) in. (38, 43 (48.5) cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

Finished Height About 6 1/2 (6 1/2, 7 1/2) in. (16 (16, 19) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 136-109 [Lion Brand Heartland](#)

Yarn: Olympic

1 Ball (A)

- 136-135 [Lion Brand Heartland](#)

Yarn: Yosemite

1 Ball (B)

- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size H-](#)

8 (5 mm)

Needles (Set of 6)

**Heartland (Article #136). Solids: 100% Acrylic
T eeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size:
Solids: 5oz/142g (251yd/230m)
T eeds: 4oz/113g (200yd/183m)*



GAUGE:

14 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

hdc2tog (hdc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

1. Scarf is worked in one piece, changing color to create stripes.
2. Hat is worked in one piece in the rnd, changing color to create stripes.
3. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st. For wide stripes, fasten off old color and proceed with new color. For narrow stripes, carry color not in use up side of piece.
4. When you see '0' repeats in an instruction, this means that you should not perform that particular

instruction, just skip to the next part of the instruction.

SCARF

With A, ch 22.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first hdc) and in each ch across – 21 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, hdc in next hdc and in each hdc across.

Rep Row 2 as follows: Work 3 more rows with A, 3 rows with B, 41 rows with A, 41 rows with B, 3 rows with A, 5 rows with B.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

HAT

With B, ch 54, (60, 64). Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc in this rnd and in all following rnds), hdc in next ch and in each ch around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 54 (60, 64) sts.

Rnd 2: Ch 2, hdc in next hdc and in each hdc around; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Rep Rnd 2 as follows: Work 5 (5, 6) rnds with A, 5 (5, 6) rnds with B.

Fasten off B.

Continue with A only.

Work 2 rnds with A.

Shape Crown (top of Hat)

Dec Rnd 1: Ch 2, hdc in next 3 sts, hdc2tog, *hdc in next 4 sts, hdc2tog; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – you will have 45 (50, 55) hdc at the end of this rnd.

Dec Rnd 2: Ch 2, hdc in next 2 sts, hdc2tog, *hdc in next 3 sts, hdc2tog; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 36 (40, 44) hdc.

Dec Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc in next st, hdc2tog, *hdc in next 2 sts, hdc2tog; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 27 (30, 33) hdc.

Dec Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc2tog, *hdc in next st, hdc2tog; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 18 (20, 22) hdc.

Dec Rnd 5: Ch 1, hdc in next st (beg ch and hdc count as first hdc2tog), *hdc2tog; rep from * around; join with sl st in first hdc – 9 (10, 11) hdc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail through remaining sts and pull to gather. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
