# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice®

### Raspberry Scarf

**SKILL LEVEL:** Beginner (Level 1)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 7 x 52 in. (18 x 132 cm).

#### MATERIALS

- 860-102 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Aqua 2 Balls (A) *\*Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic*  
***400, 401, 403:** 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon*
- 860-112 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Raspberry 2 Balls (B) ***402:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)*  
***Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers:** 3 ozs (85 g) , 145 yards (133 meters)*
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I-9 ***Twists:** 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)*
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



#### GAUGE:

13 half double crochet = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### NOTES:

1. Three strips are worked separately, then sewn together to make the Scarf.
2. Each strip is worked in both colors of yarn.
3. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the stitch. Fasten off old color.
4. When changing color, leave long yarn tails to weave in later.

#### SCARF

##### Strip 1 (make 2)

With A, chain 10.

**Row 1:** Half double crochet in 3rd chain from hook (beginning 2 chain does not count as a stitch), half double crochet in each chain across – at the end of Row 1 you will have 8 stitches.

**Rows 2-6:** Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across.

**Row 7:** Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across, changing to B in last stitch.

**Rows 8-13:** With B, chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across.

**Row 14:** Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch), turn, half double crochet in each stitch across, changing to A in last stitch.

**Row 15:** With A, repeat Row 2.

Repeat Rows 2-15 for 8 more times, then repeat Rows 2-7 once more.

Fasten off.

### **Strip II (make 1)**

With B, chain 10.

Work same as Strip I, reversing colors.

### **FINISHING**

Sew a Strip I to each long side of Strip II.

Weave in ends.
