- 135-170 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Hometown USA Yarn: Las</u> <u>Vegas Gold</u> 1 Ball (A)
- 135-099 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Hometown USA Yarn: Los</u> <u>Angeles Tan</u> 1 Ball (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook -Size N-13 (9 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*<u>Hometown USA</u> (Article #135). **Solids, Multis, Neons and Team:** 100% Acrylic **Tweeds:** 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m) **Multis, Tweeds, Neons, and Team:** 4 oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)



GAUGE:

Row 1 = 8 1/2 in. (21.5 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Circle Scarfie is worked as a rectangle, then short edges are sewn tog to make a circle. 2. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

CIRCLE SCARFIE

With A, ch 18.

Row 1: Sc in 4th ch from hook (skipped 3 ch count as first ch-sp), *ch 2, sk next ch, sc in next ch; rep from * across – 8 sc and 8 ch-sps.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first ch-sp), turn, sc in first ch-sp, *ch 2, sc in next ch-sp; rep from * across

working last sc in turning ch-sp – 8 sc and 8 ch-sps. Rep Row 2 until one yard (1 meter) remains, changing to B in last st of last row. With B, rep Row 2 until one yard (1 meter) remains. Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

FINISHING

Using yarn tail, sew short edges tog to make Circle Scarfie. Weave in ends.
