GAUGE:

15 sts + 30 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row). One Square = about 8 x 8 in. (20.5 x 20.5 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Throw is made from 24 striped and mitered Squares.
- 2. The stripes are made by changing yarn color; the miters by working a decrease in the center of every other row.
- 3. The outer Squares are worked, then sts are picked up along the edges to make subsequent Squares. This reduces the amount of sewing!
- 4. Two side sections of 9 Squares each are worked and joined first. Then sts are picked up along an edge of one Square in each of the 2 side sections to beg inner Squares and join the side sections together. Unjoined edges between Squares and the 2 end Squares are sewn in place to complete the Throw.
- 5. Follow the Assembly Diagram for placement and direction of Squares.
- 6. With yarn in front (wyif) refers to the side of the work facing you as you work the row.
- 7. When slipping sts, slip as if to purl.



THROW

First Outer Section

Square 1

With A, cast on 59 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K28, k3tog tbl, place marker (pm), k27, sl 1 wyif – 57 sts.

Row 2: K to last st, slipping marker as you come to it, sl 1 wyif.

Row 3: K to 2 sts before marker, sl next 2 sts to right needle, remove marker, sl 2 sts on right needle back to left needle, k3tog tbl, replace marker, k to last st, sl 1 wyif – 55 sts.

Note: Remember to slip sts as if to purl to avoid twisting the sts.

Rows 4 and 5: Rep Rows 2 and 3 – 53 sts.

Change to B.

Rows 6-13: With B, rep Rows 2 and 3 four times – 45 sts rem at the end of Row 13.

Change to C.

Rows 14-55: Continue to rep Rows 2 and 3, changing color as follows: work 8 rows with C, 4 rows with A, 8 rows with B, 8 rows with C, 2 rows with A, 6 rows with C, 6 rows with A – 3 sts rem at the end of Row 55

Continue with A only and remove marker as you work Row 56.

Row 56: K2, sl 1 wyif. **Row 57:** K3tog tbl.

Fasten off last st.

Squares 2-8

Make same as Square 1.

Square 9

With A, cast on 30 sts.

From RS and following Assembly Diagram, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across side of Square 1 – 59 sts

Work Rows 1-57 of Square 1 using D instead of B and E instead of C.

Fasten off last st.

Square 10

From RS, with A and following Assembly Diagram, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across next side of Square 1, cast on 1 st, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across side of Square 2 – 59 sts. Work same as Square 9.

Fasten off last st.

Square 11

From RS, with A and following Assembly Diagram, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across next side of Square 2, cast on 1 st, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across side of Square 3 – 59 sts. Work same as Square 9.

Fasten off last st.

Square 12

From RS, with A and following Assembly Diagram, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across next side of Square 3, cast on 1 st, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across side of Square 4 – 59 sts. Work same as Square 9.

Fasten off last st.

Square 13

From RS, with A and following Assembly Diagram, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across next side of Square 4, cast on 30 sts – 59 sts.

Work same as Square 9.

Fasten off last st.

Second Outer Section

Square 14

Work same as Square 9, following Assembly Diagram to pick up sts across side of Square 5.

Squares 15-18

Work same as Square 10, following Assembly Diagram and picking up sts across sides of Squares 5-8.

Square 19 (separate end Square)

With A, cast on and work same as for Square 1, using F instead of B and G instead of C. Fasten off last st.

Inner Joining Section

Square 20

From RS, with A and following Assembly Diagram, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across side of Square 10, cast on 1 st, pick up and k 29 sts evenly spaced across side of Square 17.

Work Rows 1-57 of Square 1 using F instead of B and G instead of C.

Fasten off last st.

Square 21

From RS, with A and following Assembly Diagram, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across side of Square 11, cast on 1 st, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across side of Square 16.

Work same as Square 20. Fasten off last st.

Square 22

From RS, with A and following Assembly Diagram, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across rem side of Square 16, cast on 1 st, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across rem side of Square 11.

Work same as Square 20.

Place last st onto a st holder.

Square 23

From RS, with A and following Assembly Diagram, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across edge of Square 15, k st on st holder, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across edge of Square 12. Work same as Square 20.


Fasten off last st.

Square 24 (separate end Square)

Cast on and work same as Square 19. Fasten off last st.

FINISHING

Lay Throw onto a flat surface. Sew rem edges of Squares 20-23 to adjacent Squares. Following Assembly Diagram, sew Square 19 to rem free edges of Squares 9 and 18 and Square 24 to Squares 13 and 14.



Edging

From RS, with crochet hook and A, and beg at point of Square 19, *single crochet into next st, chain 5, skip 1 st; rep from * around entire outside of piece. Join with slip st to first single crochet. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
