Lion Brand® Heartland Next Generation Blanket

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SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

About 27 x 36 in. (68.5 x 91.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- 136-098 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Acadia
1 Ball (A)
- 136-305 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Glacier Bay Tweed
1 Ball (B)
- 136-350 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Mount Rainier Tweed
1 Ball (C)
- 136-353 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Black Canyon Tweed
1 Ball (D)
- Clover Bamboo Circular Knitting Needles 36" Size 9
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

Heartland (Article #136). **Solids: 100% Acrylic*

***Tweeds:** 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 5oz/142g (251yd/230m)*

***Tweeds:** 4oz/113g (200yd/183m)*



GAUGE:

16 sts + 22 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Blanket is worked in one piece, changing color to create stripes.
2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working on straight needles.



BLANKET

With A, cast on 108 sts.

Rows 1-12: Work in Garter st (knit every row) for beginning border.

Row 13 (WS): K7, p to last 7 sts, k7.

Row 14: Knit.

Rep Rows 13 and 14, thus working first and last 7 sts in Garter st for borders and center sts in St st (k on RS, p on WS), until piece measures about 9 in. (23 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Cut A and join B.

With B, rep Rows 13 and 14 until piece measures about 18 in. (46 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Cut B and join C.

With C, rep Rows 13 and 14 until piece measures about 27 in. (68.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Cut C and join D.

With D, rep Rows 13 and 14 until piece measures about 34 1/2 in. (87.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Last 12 rows: Rep Rows 1-12 for ending border.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
