GAUGE:

11 dc + 7 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the [gauge](#) in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

1. The yarn color is changed every 14 rows to create stripes.
2. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the stitch. Fasten off old color.
3. The chain 3 at the beginning of every row is a turning chain and does not count as a stitch.



BLANKET

With A, chain 115.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across – 112 sts at the end of this row.

Rows 2-14: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across. Change to B in last st of Row 14.

Rows 15-28: With B, rep Row 2. Change to C in last st of Row 28.

Rows 29-42: With C, rep Row 2. Change to D in last st of Row 42.

Rows 43-56: With D, rep Row 2. Change to E in last st of Row 56.

Rows 57-70: With E, rep Row 2. Change to F in last st of Row 70.

Rows 71-84: With F, rep Row 2.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
