\*LB Collection Silk Chiffon Ribbon (Article #497). 100% silk; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (90yds/82m) pull

## **MATERIALS**

- 497-asstd Lion Brand LB Collection Silk Chiffon Ribbon
  - 1 Ball (A)
- 640-154 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Grey Marble
  - 1 Ball (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size Q-19 (15.75)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

\*Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists, Prints, Stripes: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly;

package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g

(106 yd/97 m) Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)

Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)





#### **GAUGE:**

3 pattern reps + 5 rnds = about 8 in.(20.5 cm) with one strand each of A and B held tog. **Note:** One pattern rep consists of one 2-dc group and the following ch-2 sp.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

hdc2tog (hdc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

#### NOTES:

- 1. Cowl is worked in joined rnds beg at lower edge. Do not turn at beg of rnds, work with RS always facing.
- 2. One strand each of A and B are held tog throughout. Sts are worked in back loops only.
- 3. If you find it difficult to join the beg ch into a ring without twisting the ch, Rnd 1 can be worked as a row, then

joined into a rnd, as follows: Leaving a long beg tail, ch 62, dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as first dc), \*ch 2, sk next 2 ch, dc in next 2 ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, ch 2, sk last 2 ch - 30 dc (Fifteen 2-dc groups). Use beg tail to sew end of foundation ch to base of first 3 skipped ch. Proceed to Rnd 2.

#### COWL

With one strand each of A and B held tog, ch 60. Taking care not to twist ch; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next ch, \*ch 2, sk next 2 ch, dc in next 2 ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, ch 2, sk last 2 ch; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – you will have 30 dc (fifteen 2-dc groups) and 15 ch-2 sps at the end of this rnd.

**Note:** In Rnds 2-7, work all sts in back loops only.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 5 (counts as dc + ch 2), sk first 2 dc, dc in each ch of next ch-2 sp, \*ch 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in each ch of next ch-2 sp; rep from \* to last 2dc, ch 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in first ch of last ch-2 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Rnd 3:** SI st in first ch of first ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next ch, \*ch 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in each ch of next ch-2 sp; rep from \* around, ch 2, sk last 2 dc; join with sI st in top of beg ch-3.

Rnds 4 and 5: Rep Rnds 2 and 3.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 2, hdc in next st (tog with beg ch counts as hdc2tog), \*ch 1, sk next ch-2 sp, hdc2tog; rep from \* around, ch 1, sk last ch-2 sp; join with sl st in first hdc2tog – 15 hdc2tog and 15 ch-1 sps.

**Rnd 7:** SI st in first ch-1sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), \*ch 1, sk next hdc2tog, dc in next ch-1; rep from \* around, ch 1, sk last hdc2tog; join with sI st in top of beg ch-3 – 15 dc and 15 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
