MATERIALS

*<u>Landscapes</u> (Article #545). 100% acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (147yds/134m) pull skeins

• 545-200 <u>Lion Brand Landscapes:</u> <u>Tropics</u>

1 Ball

 <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size</u> K-10.5 (6.5 mm)

 <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

3 blocks = about $4 \frac{1}{2}$ in. (11.5 cm); 6 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

Circle Scarfie is worked as a rectangle, then sewed together to make a circle.

CIRCLE SCARFIE

Ch 120.

Row 1: Work 2 dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc – first block made), sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch, *ch 3, dc in next 3 ch (block made), sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch; rep from * across – you will have 17 blocks at the end of this row. **Rows 2-12:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, 2 dc in first sc (first block made), *sk next 3 dc, (sc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next ch-3 sp, dc in next sc (block made); rep from * across, sc in top of turning ch.

Top Edging: Turn, sl st in each sc, each ch, and each dc across.

Fasten off.

Lower Edging: Working across opposite side of foundation ch, join yarn with a sl st in ch at base of first st, sl st in each ch across.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

FINISHING

With yarn tail, sew ends of Circle Scarfie together. Weave in ends.
