# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Landscapes® Grandma's Apple Pie #Scarfie Pattern Number: L40557

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy + (Level 3)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 5 1/2 x 43 in. (14 x 109 cm)

### MATERIALS

- 545-205 [Lion Brand Landscapes: Apple Orchard](#)  
1 Ball
  - [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I-9](#)
  - [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)
- \*Landscapes (Article #545). 100% acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (147yds/134m) pull skeins*



### GAUGE:

6 pattern reps + 3 1/2 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 2 and 3. **Note:** One pattern rep consists of a dc2tog and the following ch-2 sp on odd-numbered rows, and a sc and the following ch-14 sp on even-numbered rows.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**dc2tog (dc 2 sts together)** (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

**dc2tog (worked over 2 ch-sps)**

**Note:** You will be working the dc2tog into the next 2 ch-sps. Skip the sc between the ch-sps.

**Step 1:** Yarn over, insert hook in first indicated ch-sp and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops (first half of dc2tog complete);

**Step 2:** Yarn over, insert hook in next indicated ch-sp and draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops (second half of dc2tog complete);

**Step 3:** Yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook (dc2tog complete).

**dc2tog-over-3 (dc 2 together worked over 3 ch)** Yarn over, insert hook in next ch and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops, skip next ch, yarn over, insert hook in

next ch and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 2 sts decreased.

## SCARFIE

Leaving a long beg yarn tail, about 24 in. (61 cm) long, ch 27.

**Row 1:** Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch and first dc count as first dc2tog), \*ch 2, dc2tog-over-3; rep from \* to last 2 ch, ch 2, dc2tog – you will have 9 dc2tog and 8 ch-2 sps at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 14, turn, sk first dc2tog, sc in next dc2tog, \*ch 14, sc in next dc2tog; rep from \* to end of row – 8 sc and 8 ch-14 sps.

**Row 3:** Ch 9, turn, dc in first ch-sp (last 3 ch of turning ch and first dc count as first dc2tog), \*ch 2, dc2tog over same ch-sp and next ch-sp; rep from \* to end of row, ch 2, dc2tog all in same (last) ch-sp – 9 dc2tog and 8 ch-2 sps.

**Rows 4-39:** Rep last 2 rows 18 more times.

**Last Row:** Ch 1, turn, sl st in each dc2tog and ch to end of row.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

With beg yarn tail, sl st in each ch across opposite side of foundation ch.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
