MATERIALS

- 135-215 [Lion Brand Hometown USA Yarn: Little Rock Granite](#)
3 Balls
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13 \(9 mm\)](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

**Hometown USA (Article #135). Solids, Multis, Neons and Twists: 100% Acrylic, Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Cotton; package size: Solids: 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m) Multis, Tweeds, Neons, and Twists: 4 oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)*



GAUGE:

8 1/2 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the [gauge](#) in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

The 2 skipped chs at the beginning of Row 1 do not count as a st, and the ch 2 at the beg of all other rows do not count as sts. Do not work hdcs into the beg chs!

SCARFIE

Ch 18.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across for a total of 16 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st across.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures about 50 in. (127 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
