 2 Balls (A)
- 137-109 <u>Lion Brand</u>
 <u>Heartland Thick & Quick</u>
 <u>Yarn: Olympic</u>
 2 Balls (B)
- 137-135 <u>Lion Brand</u>
 <u>Heartland Thick & Quick</u>
 <u>Yarn: Yosemite</u>

2 Balls (C)

- 137-126 <u>Lion Brand</u>
 <u>Heartland Thick & Quick</u>
 <u>Yarn: Sequoia</u>
 2 Balls (D)
- Lion Brand Size 11 [8 mm]
 29-inch [75 cm] Circular
 Knitting Needles
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u>

*<u>Heartland Thick & Quick</u> (Article #137). 100% acrylic; package size: 5.00oz/141.75 gr. (125yds/114m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

11 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Stockinette st (k on RS, p on WS).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Blanket is worked in one piece, changing yarn color every 36 rows to create stripes.
- 2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle as if working with straight needles.



BLANKET

With A, cast on 96 sts. **Rows 1 and 2:** Knit.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4 (WS): K25, p23, k23, p23, k2.

Rows 5-38: Rep Rows 3 and 4.

Change to B.

Row 39 (RS): Knit.

Row 40: K2, p23, k23, p23, k25. **Rows 41-74:** Rep Rows 39 and 40.

Change to C. Rep Rows 3-38. Change to D. Rep Rows 39-74. Knit 3 rows.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
