545-203 <u>Lion Brand</u>
 <u>Landscapes: Sand Dune</u>
 2 Balls

\*Landscapes (Article #545). 100% acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (147yds/134m) pull skeins

 Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 10 [6 mm]

 Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



### **GAUGE:**

19 1/2 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Rib Check pattern.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

## STITCH EXPLANATION:

### PATTERN EXPLANATION

Rib Check pattern (worked over a multiple of 4 sts + 2 extra sts)

Rows 1 and 3: K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* across to end of row.

Rows 2 and 4: P2, \*k2, p2; rep from \* across to end of row.

Rows 5 and 6: Knit.

Rows 7 and 9: P2, \*k2, p2; rep from \* across to end of row.

Rows 8 and 10: K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* across to end of row.

**Rows 11 and 12:** Knit.

Rep Rows 1-12 for Rib Check pattern.

### **NOTES:**

Circle Scarfie is worked as a long strip, then seamed to make a circle.

# CIRCLE SCARFIE

Cast on 34 sts.

Beg with Row 1, work in Rib Check pattern until piece measures about 40 in. (101.5 cm) from beg, end with a Row 6 or 12 as the last row you work. Bind off, leaving a long yarn tail.

### **FINISHING**

With yarn tail, sew ends of piece together to make Circle Scarfie. Weave in ends.
