Finished Hat Circumference About 20 in. (51 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Scarf About 7 1/2 x 56 in. (19 x 142 cm)

MATERIALS

136-149 <u>Lion Brand Heartland</u>
 <u>Yarn: Great Smoky Mountains</u>
 3 Balls

• <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles</u>-Size 8 [5 mm]

Pom pom Maker

• <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> <u>Needles (Set of 6)</u>

Additional Materials

MATERIALS NOTE

You'll need one ball to make the Hat only, 2 balls to make Scarf only. *<u>Heartland</u> (Article #136). **Solids:** 100% Acrylic

Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 5oz/142g

(251yd/230m)

Tweeds: 4oz/113g (200yd/183m)



GAUGE:

23 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern, slightly stretched.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

Hat is worked back and forth in rows, the seamed.

HAT

Cast on 115 sts.

Row 1: K3, *p1, k3; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: K1, *p1, k3; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 11 in. (28 cm) from beg.

Last Row: *K2tog; rep from * to last st, k1.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and pull to gather. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Sew sides together for back seam of Hat. Following package directions, make a pom-pom. Tie pom-pom to top of Hat.

Weave in ends.

SCARF

Cast on 43 sts.

Row 1: K3, *p1, k3; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: K1, *p1, k3; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 56 in. (142 cm) from beg.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
